ZEHNER'S ZENNA was not asked for speed early, circled four wide on the turn, rallied steadily in the lane and was up late to win driving. CONFUCIUS JUNIOR tracked the dueling leaders from the outset, raced just off the rail on the turn, forged to the front leaving the furlong pole and just failed to last. PLANET SUNSHINE raced unhurried early, was just off the rail on the turn and finished steadily. SHOW OFF saved ground to no avail. JIDDAW settled early, moved up three wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. TRIBAL SIGN dueled outside DON'T STOP RIDING, disposed of that rival into the stretch but slackened once headed leaving the furlong pole. DON'T STOP RIDIN' dueled from the rail for a half mile and gave out.
