Footnotes

TIGER'S MISTRESS was permitted to settle early, raced up in traffic on the turn, angled four wide into the stretch, rallied steadily to gain command in the final stages and won driving. UNBRIDLED JOULE stalked pace two wide from the outset, gained command past the furlong pole but could not stall the winner. PURE STORM tracked the pace from the inside under a snug hold, was boxed behind a tiring LUCKY AFFAIR at the furlong pole and raced in checked, finally got outside near the sixteenth pole and closed willingly. STYLIN JULIE settled early, saved ground to the stretch and went evenly late. LUCKY AFFAIR set all of the pace, saved ground into the lane but gave way at the furlong pole. ANCIENT ARTIFACT steadied at the start to fall behind and lagged then failed to rally while four wide into the stretch. MISS KONA BREW lacked good early speed, raced three wide on the turn and did not respond. MARK IN MONTEREY raced in mid pack early but fell back while two wide on the turn.
