Footnotes

EAST FROM WEST had no speed and trailed to the second turn, was roused leaving the three eighths, got forced six wide into the stretch then finished willingly in the final furlong and was going away. SIMPLE JUSTICE tracked the pace to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn, pushed to the front into the stretch, was clear to mid stretch then could not stall the winner late. TOP BROCCOLI hesitated and was away slowly but was hustled to the front, set a pressured pace while off the rail for six furlongs but tired in the stretch. TENSE BET tracked the pace to the half, was two wide on the second turn while attempting to rally but came up empty in the drive. PEPITO AT LAST was outsprinted, settled to the half, got fanned five wide on the second turn and failed to mount a late response. AGGRESSION prompted the pace to the second turn but gave out after six furlongs.
