Footnotes

OFFICE HOURS was well positioned just off the pace early, moved up on the turn but became boxed behind a tiring BORNE TO ROMP, eased outside once in the stretch, rallied quickly to gain command past mid stretch and just held AVULSION in the final strides. AVULSION raced unhurried early, circled rivals from the four path on the turn to loom a bold factor in the upper stretch but came up just a bit short. DODGER stalked the leader from the outset, rallied to the lead when that rival stopped entering the lane, was clear briefly but could not last. MOONS PRIDE trailed early, raced in the two path on the turn and closed a gap in the lane. CASH UP FRONT settled early, advanced two wide to the stretch then lost his punch. FUTSAIDA JOE stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and gave out. GRATIS settled early, rallied from the four path into the stretch but flattened out. BOURNE TO ROMP sprinted clear and led to the quarter pole then stopped suddenly.
