Footnotes

VICTORY KNOCK was bumped at the start but quickly recovered to gain a short early lead, dueled from off the rail throughout, edged away from FANTQASTIC NIGHT but was engaged by ESCAPING THE STORM and held gamely. ESCAPING THE STORM stalked the winner from the rail, remained inside into the stretch to rally steadily but could not quite get by late. FANTASTIC NIGHT dueled outside the winner to the deep stretch and slackened. MOMMY GO TOO settled early, saved ground to the stretch and closed a gap. MR. FURIOUS was bumped and squeezed off at the start to lag, came through inside on the turn and finished with some speed. GEAR SHIFT raced unhurried early, was fanned four wide on the turn to lose ground but regain his stride in the lane and came back on. STONEWALL RIOT stalked the winner from the four path and came up empty. KRAZY FLYER flashed only brief speed.
