CURLY BOY was permitted to settle early from off the rail, moved closer into the second turn, came three wide to the stretch, rallied determinedly and was up late. JERRY'S FEVER raced up two wide on the first turn to gain command and set all of the pace, dropped inside on the second turn, met a bid from GLOBAL GLOW at mid turn, remained inside for the drive and gave way grudgingly. GLOBAL GLOW stalked the pace three wide early, challenged two wide on the second turn but could not get by JERRY'S FEVER or hold the winner. FUNNYCUS took back early and was rank through the opening half mile, settled while three wide on the second turn but did not make a serious impact until the final stages. PEPPERED PRO was never too far back, raced two wide on both turns but lacked the needed response. ATIZ saved ground to no avail. CODYS A BOBCAT lagged early from off the rail, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but came up empty.
