Footnotes

BRITE BAY broke alertly and stalked VALID DOUBLE for the lead, advanced outside that rival once on the backstretch to be challenging for command at the half pole, dueled into the lane and gradually pulled clear driving. POLY OLE was rank to place from the inside to the five eighths pole then settled, shifted three wide on the second turn, challenged for command from the extreme outside in the upper stretch but lost her punch late. VALID DOUBLE set the pace from the rail to the second turn, continued to duel to the furlong pole and slackened. ITALIAN WINE raced unhurried early from just off the rail, dropped inside for the second turn but had no rally. STORM OF THE NILE was permitted to settle early, tried to rally while outside ITALIAN WINE on the second turn but came up empty. SASSY LINDA broke a bit slow then raced up four wide on the first turn to reach contention once on the backstretch then stopped nearing the second turn and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
