**Footnotes**

BLUE IMP settled in from the rail within striking distance early, moved closer into the second turn, swung out and quickly challenged ITALIAN WINE two wide at the quarter pole, drew clear in the upper stretch and held driving. BLUE MOONRAY raced unhurried early, circled rivals four wide on the second turn and continued to rally in the drive. ITALIAN WINE took a quick early lead and raced unchallenged to the second turn, gave way to the winner into the lane and weakened. ROAD TO KISSES lagged to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch, angled out and came on without being a serious factor. SLEWREEN stalked the pace two wide to the second turn and came up empty. MERCILESS lagged early in hand, followed BLUE MOONRAY around horses on the second turn but flattened out in the drive. FLYINDOWNBAYLAUREL settled early, saved ground throughout but did not rally. ZEE BEST was forwardly placed from the outside to the second turn and gave out. FLYING JACKIE was never a factor. SULTRY STYLE had no speed then pulled up lame after the race and was vanned off.
