**Footnotes**

MUTAK GOLD was never too far back, saved ground on the turn, shifted out once in the stretch, rallied determinedly and was up late. TRILLIANT dueled outside HEXBREAKER from the outset, forged to the front on the turn but could not quite last. SCOTTISH DIAMOND raced close up early, slipped back slightly while four wide on the turn but finished steadily from the outside. DAVOS broke slow and lacked good early speed, saved ground into the lane and closed willingly. HEXBREAKER dueled from the rail into the stretch and weakened. MTN RANCH WILLY tracked the leaders from the outside, moved up three wide on the turn to loom a bold factor once in the stretch but lacked the needed response. PUNCH UP was void of speed to the stretch, angled widest and finished full of run. PAPA DO RIGHT stalked the pace two wide to the stretch but went evenly in the lane. PHANTOM STRIKE lacked good early speed, came two wide to the strtrch and closed a gap. JIMMY DA BRICK settled early then lacked the needed response while three wide into the lane. BERT'S LAW settled early, raced four wide on the turn but could not reach serious contention.
