CHOCOLATE CANDY was unhurried for a half mile, offered a quick bid when roused into the second turn, moved to the front in upper stretch then dug in late and edged clear. AXEL FOLEY was allowed to settle to the second turn, advanced inside to the stretch then finished willingly but could not threaten the winner. MERUS MIAMI was crowded by FEISTY SUANCES at the start, settled on the first turn, was asked for speed nearing the three eighths, got fanned four wide but closed ground to loom a factor into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. FEISTY SUANCES broke out at the start and crowded MERUS MIAMI, attended the pace to the half mile pole, pushed past REVOLUTA and was the leader on the second turn but was overtaken by the winner in upper stretch and tired. GALLANT SON was four wide on the first turn and trailed to the second turn, rallied three wide to briefly reach contention but faded in the final eighth. ADRIATIC MOON chased the pace to the half, was three wide to the stretch and gave out in the drive. REVOLUTA set a pressured pace for five furlongs, stopped on the second turn then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
