TIJUANA TUESDAY stalked the pace to the turn, moved smoothly three wide and took over nearing the quarter pole then drew clear to mid stretch and kicked away to the line in an impressive debut. BABY GOTHAM was outrun to the turn, saved ground to the stretch, did not threaten the winner but finished steadily for the place. COMIC FOOL had good speed, led to the turn, was overtaken by the winner nearing the quarter pole then tired through the stretch. EASTER CANDY broke sluggishly and had no speed, saved ground to the stretch then gradually worked his way past rivals in the drive. BLACK EASTER had no speed and saved ground to no avail. PATS PRIDE also had no speed and was never a threat. MATITUDE was outrun to the turn, raced four wide to the stretch then had nothing to offer in the drive. BONE CHILLIN COLD chased the leaders to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then weakened through the lane. SPARK'S LAKE also chased the pace, came three wide to the stretch and gave way. AMERICA'S KID had only brief speed then stopped. FREEDOM EVENT gave a dull effort.
