Footnotes

NOISE OF THE CROWD broke in stride and raced up outside PERFECT FASHION into the first turn to gain command, disposed of that rival nearing the stretch, met a bid from DREAM OF DAISY once in the stretch and edged clear driving. DREAM OF DAISY was permitted to settle early from off the rail, eased three wide on the second turn to rally into the stretch but lost her punch. PERFECT FASHION prompted the winner from the rail for six furlongs and slackened. MEDICI PEARL (GB) broke in the air to be off five lengths behind the field and raced unhurried to the second turn, then tried to rally three wide to the stretch but had no response. PALM BEACH STORY stalked the pace early and gave way from just off the rail on the second turn. REAL STEAM settled early, offered a brief bid from the two path on the second turn but had nothing left for the drive.
