Footnotes

BOBBY HANDY was permitted to settle well off the early leaders and raced unhurried to the second turn, rallied to the lead three wide into the stretch then outdueled STORMY SURGE in the final furlong. STORMY SURGE was not asked for speed early from the rail, commenced his bid four wide on the second turn, challenged in the upper stretch but could not get by the winner. CHUMAREE RED lagged from off the rail, came four wide on the second turn to rally into the stretch but lost some of his punch late. MUSIC APPEAL was void of speed to the second turn then closed a gap from the inside. KISSN TRISTAN settled early, saved ground throughout but went evenly through the stretch. IRON JOE T dueled outside SKATTLE SEATTLE to the second turn, edged clear but had little left once in the stretch. SKATTLE SEATTLE took a long lead with IRON JOE T to the second turn and gave out.
