Footnotes

RULE THE STORM took back at the start and lagged to the second turn, angled to the three path into the stretch, split horses a furlong out, wore down OUR ROAD SCHOLAR nearing the finish without need of the whip in a well judged ride. OUR ROAD SCHOLAR stalked the pace from the outset, took command after a half mile and dueled into the lane, edged clear at the furlong pole but could not hold the winner late. MI CORREDORA settled early from the inside, moved up two wide on the second turn to loom a factor but lacked the needed rally. GOOD THOUGHTS stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs and weakened. PAMELOT was never too far back, moved up four wide on the second turn and lost her punch. MERRY MARINO set the pace from the inside early, dueled to the strch and gave out.
