Footnotes

LILLY'S PERFECT was a step slow at the break, was kept out widest while four deep to the backstretch, eased in and moved up two wide on the second turn, responded inside in the stretch and wore down ALWAYSINCONTENTION late. CENTRAL HEAT stalked the pace to the second turn, was forced to bid four wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch but kept to task and closed but was too late. ALWAYSINCONTENTION set all the pace for six furlongs, responded to pressure to mid stretch then could not hold. LOOKIN FOR JONESY had no speed, settled for a half mile, came two wide to the stretch then shifted out and closed willingly late. INNER GROOVE stalked the leaders inside of CENTRAL HEAT to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch but slackened in the drive. PURE STORM was outsprinted in the opening quarter mile and saved ground throughout but lacked a rally when asked.
