LORNEFIVEHUNDRED chased the pace to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, shifted out for room in upper stretch then rallied determinedly when set down and pushed clear. ERNIE OWL stalked the leader early, was two wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch but kept to task, split foes late and grabbed the place. SKYRIBBON was also stalking to the turn, raced three deep to the stretch, also was outrun to mid stretch then could not muster the needed late response.. RED COATS R COMIN set the pace from the rail to the stretch, responded to pressure to deep stretch but was weakening late. BRUNO'S WAGER was chasing to the turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch, rallied to loom a threat to mid stretch but went evenly in the final sixteenth. IDLE CHATTER broke a bit slow and trailed.
