Footnotes

CODI DEE was unhurried to the half, bid two wide into the second turn, eased out four wide and split rivals into the stretch, edged to the front in mid stretch then drew clear under steady urging. SHE LAUGHS AN FLYS set the pace to the second turn, was in the two path to the stretch, could not stall the winner in mid stretch but was not threatened for the place. HEART'S MUSIC stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, remained inside to the stretch but lacked the needed closing response. SERENGETI SUNRISE had no speed, bid three wide into the second turn, was forced out six wide into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. COUNT ME TWICE hopped a bit at the start then pressed the pace three wide to the second turn but had little left for the stretch run. HERE COMES RAY RAY pressed the pace to the half, was fanned out five wide to the stretch and gave way.
