**Footnotes**

CREDITCARDPURCHASE broke alertly then was permitted to fall well back, commenced her bid two wide on the turn, offered a quick rally into the stretch, collared EASY APPROVAL inside the furlong pole and drew clear driving. EASY APPROVAL (PER) dueled outside SUMMER SAILS to the turn, drew well clear into the stretch but could not stall the winner in midstretch but held well for the place. PAPIER MACHE raced unhurried early, saved ground and came on late without being a serious factor. CIRCLE Z was void of any early speed then closed a gap steadily in the final three eighths. SUMMER SAILS dueled from the rail to the turn, could not go with EASY APPROVAL on the turn, drifted three wide nearing the stretch and had little left.
