STREET CONSENSUS stalked the pace to the turn, rallied three wide to engage for the lead into the stretch, pushed clear to mid stretch then drifted inward nearing the sixteenth marker but had enough of a cushion to hold. FLAMMABILITY was outsprinted to the turn, waited in the two path at the five sixteenths then shifted three wide, responded to urging in the drive and was coming on late. EXPENSIVE PENS prompted the pace to the turn, bid inside of JORDAN RIVER and dueled for the lead into the stretch then was outkicked by the winner to mid stretch and weakened. JORDAN RIVER was fractious in the gate, had the best speed, was off the rail to the turn, briefly resisted rivals to the stretch then gave way through the final furlong. LOST IN THE PARADE broke slowly and in a tangle, did not find a comfortable stride until leaving the chute, chased the leaders to the turn, eased out four wide into the stretch but gave way in the lane. LIKE IT ON TOP had no speed, got fanned four wide to the stretch and gave out.
