**Footnotes**

INCISIVE prompted the pace to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, dueled to mid stretch then edged away under steady handling. FORESEEABLE FUTURE was outrun to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, was blocked briefly nearing mid stretch behind rivals but quickly angled out for room and finished willingly once clear. KOFINHO was outsprinted in the early stages, tracked the leaders from the rail to the stretch, rallied up to engage for the lead in mid stretch but weakened in the late going. SWISS GAME set the pace while racing off the rail to the stretch, resisted rivals to mid stretch but was also weakening late. RUN FOR MILES prompted the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch but gave way through the drive. TEDDY THE BEAR tracked the leaders while caught out widest to the turn, four deep to the stretch then gave out through the lane.
