Footnotes

YANKEE BRAVO took back after the start and trailed on the first turn while crossing to the rail, advanced gradually from the inside on the backstretch, shifted out to be three wide and caught in heavy traffic on the second turn, steadied briefly behind the leaders into the stretch, shifted out and quickly responded to gain command late and won driving. CAFE TORTONI was permitted to settle from the rail on the first turn but was never far out of it, advanced two wide on the second turn, steadied inside the winner and behind a wall of horses leaving the quarter pole, eased out for room once in the stretch, challenged for command outside VICTORY PETE in mid stretch but could not go with the winner. VICTORY PETE dueled from off the rail throughout and finished gamely. TRES BORRACHOS raced close up and four wide to the backstretch, remained a serious factor four wide on the second turn but could not muster the needed response. ROBSCARVIC (IRE) pressed the pace from the rail throughout, gained a short lead on the second turn but slackened in the lane. MEDJOOL was well placed from off the rail to the second turn, slackened leaving the three eighths pole then steadied sharply on the rail inside CAFE TORTONI near the quarter pole. SPINNING SOUND (IRE) raced up four wide on the first turn and forwardly placed, was fanned five wide on the second turn and weakened in the drive. OVERLAND broke slow and lagged from the rail, remained inside to the stretch but never mustered a closing response. MOONLIT MASTER raced unhurried early while four wide to the backstretch and never reached contention. BERT'S LAW showed little. MANY RIVERS steadied in heavy traffic and between horses on the first turn, remained a factor to the second turn then stopped. CAPTURE THE CALL pressed the pace

four wide early, continued a pace factor three wide for six furlongs then stopped suddenly.
