HOLY MAMA gained command in the opening stages and held a clear advantage into the turn, turned back a bid from USUALLY SUPER into the stretch and drew clear driving. RUCKUSING STORM tracked the winner from the inside to mid turn, angled three wide into the lane and came on for the place without being a serious threat. USUALLY SUPER stalked the winner two wide, had her best bid at the quarter pole and faltered in the lane. APPEALING RESUME settled early then saved ground to no avail. ISLAND SHINE flashed speed to the turn and weakened. WARREN'S MYSTERY pulled up on the turn and was vanned off.
