GENERAL RULE gained command in the opening stages to set all of the pace from off the rail, edged clear on the turn., took his longest lead leaving the furlong pole but was fully extended to last. WARREN'S CONCEPT was void of any early speed, came through inside rivals but off the rail on the turn, eased to the extreme outside for the drive and closed steadily. BYE BYE SEE YA stalked two wide and between horses to the stretch but lacked a closing response. PALE OUTLAW prompted the winner from the three path into the stretch and weakened. MR. GOODFELLOW settled early, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. ROYAL STORMER stalked the winner from the rail to mid turn and gave out.
