Footnotes

DEAL BREAKER (GB) set the pace to the second turn, was overtaken briefly by MOSCATO but kept to task, battled the runnerup to deep stretch then dug in gamely to inch clear late. KNOCKOUT ARTIST stalked the pace to the half, rallied three wide to the stretch, got to terms with the winner a furlong out but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. SEE ZO GO was allowed to settle for five furlongs, tried to rally two then three wide to the stretch but went evenly through the final furlong. CHIEF RUNAWAY had no speed and settled, saved ground on the second turn, eased out for the drive but could not make an impact late. MOSCATO pressed the pace to the second turn, rallied outside the winner to briefly have his head in front leaving the quarter pole but had little left for the drive. JIDDAW stalked the pace to the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then tired. ROYAL MANGO steadied when a bit rank inside on the first turn then saved ground but was not a factor.
