PHOTO SHOPPED never far back to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, pushed to the front a furlong out and held under steady urging. BIG SKY POSSE was unhurried for five furlongs, came two wide on the second turn while being asked then was gaining ground steadily in the final furlong. DOS EQKEYS set all the pace for six furlongs, responded to pressure to the stretch, could not stall the winner in mid stretch and weakened. FU PEG HE RAT stalked the pace to the second turn, bid inside to the stretch then briefly had room inside of DOS EQKEYS in mid stretch but was crowded by that one near the sixteenth marker, had to check and did not recover. COLONEL MUSTARD broke slow and was slow to find a comfortable stride, lagged to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch and failed to be a serious threat. BATON ROO also stalked the pace to the second turn, offered a bid two wide to the stretch but faded through the drive. MICHAEL THE MAN settled mid pack to the half mile pole, tried to rally from the three path on the second turn but gave way through the stretch.
