Footnotes

TIME ON TARGET was unhurried for a half, launched a three wide rally once on the second turn, responded to steady pressure to mid stretch, took over leaving the furlong grounds then held off MAYTOWN MISSTREE late. MAYTOWN MISSTREE was allowed to settle, offered a rally four deep and outside the winner on the second turn then closed steadily in the latter stages. REPAYMA (NZ) tracked the leaders to the far turn, rallied two wide and took a short lead in upper stretch but the lead was short-lived and she weakened late. DESDEMONA (IRE) was allowed to settle, saved ground to the stretch while trying to rally but finished evenly. PLAYDEMROCKS dueled for the lead to the, responded on the second turn but tired after six furlongs. QUEENOFTHEPROM had no speed and did not threaten. MANGO DANCER was not a factor. BREEZE GAL dueled to the half, stopped suddenly after five furlongs, was eased in the stretch but walked off after crossing the finish line.
