Footnotes

LINDSAY JEAN broke alertly then took back off the pacesetter NEON QUEEN, tracked that rival to the second turn, challenged two wide leaving the three eighths, forged to the front and drew clear in the upper stretch then held driving. BUSH TRIUMPH was permitted to settle early from the outside, remained out while advanced into the second turn, came three wide to the stretch to loom a bold factor but lost some of her punch late. CRAZY ENSIGN (ARG) was never too far back from the inside, commenced her bid two wide into the second turn, dropped to the rail for the turn, appeared to brush with JANEIAN entering the lane, quickly recovered but finished with only a mild rally. JANEIAN (NZ) stalked the pace three wide from the outset, was caught in tight between horses entering the lane, appeared to brush CRAZY ENSIGN then had no real response. NATURALLY WILD was unhurried early, raced three wide throughout and failed to rally. NEON QUEEN sprinted clear leaving the chute to set all of the pace to the second turn, dueled with the winner from the rail to the upper stretch and slackened. DOUBLE CAT raced unhurried in traffic early, was shuffled back on the backstretch, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but came up empty. CANASITA (GB) lagged to the stretch and failed to mount a closing response. L'EMERAUDE (FR) settled early from the inside, remained inside and offered an early bid to the second turn then faded steadily.
