INDIAN BOBBY tracked the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch then eased out for room, bumped then brushed BLUFFSIDE nearing the three sixteenths then responded to pressure and nabbed LO'S IN THE FLOW in late stages. LO'S IN THE FLOW stalked the pace to the turn, rallied three wide to engage for the lead into the stretch, inched clear to mid stretch, responded to deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. BLUFFSIDE was outsprinted early, chased to the turn, was caught four wide to the stretch, got bumped then brushed by the winner nearing the three sixteenths, stayed on to late in the drive then lost his punch in the final sixteenth. ROCKAWAY MOON pressed the pace to the turn, was between rivals and dueling two wide to the stretch but was outkicked to mid stretch and lacked the needed late response. NEWS BEAT chased the leaders to the turn, saved ground to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. OL' STEELY BLUE flashed speed to the turn, was overtaken into the stretch then tired.
