STRONG STAR stalked the leader for five furlongs, responded when asked for speed on the second turn, moved up to engage for the lead leaving the quarter pole, battled to mid stretch then edged away late. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) was allowed to settle to the half, saved ground on the second turn then closed ground belatedly. KILKENNY (NZ) set the pace under pressure to the second turn, dug in when hooked by the winner into the stretch, resisted to mid stretch but was tiring late. QUASICOBRA had no speed and settled for a half mile, came three wide to the stretch but weakened through the drive. TWAIN'S TITAN chased the leaders to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch then gave out. BRICKYARDTRADITION trailed for the first half mile then broke down nearing the second turn and was vanned off.
