CHIEF LITTLE MAN was quickly in stride to take a clear early lead, extended the advantage from the inside entering the lane and won driving. FINAL JOURNEY was permitted to settle early, eased three wide on the turn and came on for the place. RAISING MEMO was not asked for speed early from the two path, dropped inside once in the stretch and finished steadily. TUDOR BLUE tracked the pace two wide and between horses to the stretch then failed to rally. ROSEMOUNT LAD initially showed some early speed but was shuffled back inside WILLYCAN near the five eighths pole to trail into the stretch then went evenly in the drive. ONE ROYAL STAR stalked the pace three wide and slackened. WILLYCAN tracked the pace from the rail to the head of the lane and gave way.
