Footnotes

BIG PAYDAY was well placed to the second turn, bid two wide at the three eighths then swung out four wide into the stretch, pushed to the front in mid stretch and held driving. T. K. FORTYSIX chased the pace to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, was outkicked by the winner to mid stretch but was the best of the rest. MR. SATISFACTION trailed to the second turn, swung out four wide and followed the winner into the stretch, loomed a threat a furlong out but flattened late. BIRD COLONEL pressed the pace two wide to the backstretch, moved up three deep to engage for the lead nearing the half, dueled three wide to the stretch then weakened. BRASS ANGEL was on the pace from the rail to the second turn, also responded to the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. DEMOCRACY flashed good speed, dueled two wide for six furlongs then gave out. FIND THE ANSWER was three wide early while not showing speed then was always outrun and not persevered with in the final furlong. STEAMER LANE was four wide on the first turn, moved up to engage for the lead on the backstretch, dueled briefly then fell back and stopped in the stretch.
