CAPERIA broke alertly then took back just off the rail from the rail, remained close up from the inside until mid way on the second turn, eased out to enter the lane two wide, rallied determinedly and was up in the final strides. J. SANTOS lagged to the second turn, angled four wide while commencing his rally leaving the three eighths pole and finished steadily from the extreme outside. BERTRANDIFUL was hustled to the lead into the first turn, crossed to the rail and settled, led into the lane, was headed at the furlong pole but kept gamely to his task and just missed getting back up. CALL ON CARSON prompted the pace two wide throughout, forged to a slim lead a furlong out but was outfinished through the drive. U S S OKLAHOMA settled early from the rail, continued to save ground on the second turn, rallied in the lane but was blocked in the late stages and steadied. EMERALD SHAKE broke out and bumped with SUNSET KID at the start, settled two wide to the backstretch, offered a menacing bid three wide into the lane but hung nearing the wire. SUNSET KID was bumped by EMERALD SHAKE at the start and steadied back to last, remained well out of it to the second turn but rallied steadily in the drive although never reaching serious contention.
