Footnotes

CLANDESTINY pressed the early leader, moved up outside that one to take command on the turn, kicked away to mid stretch but was tiring in the final furlong. FAMILY SOUL veered out sharply at the start, bumped into DEMOCRATIC SWEEP, straightened and chased the pace to the turn, came three wide to the stretch then was gaining ground on the tiring winner. FUNKY SOUP had the best speed, led to the turn, was overtaken by the winner mid turn, fell back to the stretch then went evenly late but was gaining. UNAPLAN lagged to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then was steered widest in the drive and closed fast but too late. DEMOCRATIC SWEEP broke a bit slow then was bumped by FAMILY SOUL and had to take up, tracked the pace to the turn, raced four wide to the stretch but was outfinished while closing the gap. DIXIE DOT CHANCE had no speed and was outrun. The rider on DEMOCRATIC SWEEP lodged an objection against the rider on FUNKY SOUP for alleged interference at the start but the stewards ruled that FUNKY SOUP was blameless and made no change.
