### Footnotes

CURVY CAT chased the pace to the turn, was inside and ran into traffic troubles leaving the quarter pole and at the end of the bend, shifted off the rail for room in upper stretch, rallied once clear, split rivals leaving mid stretch and drove to the lead. VINDI PRINCESS stalked the leaders to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch, was outside the winner after that one had shifted out, could not match strides but was second best. HARD TO PLEASE had no speed, trailed to mid turn while three wide then finished in a mild rally. QUINNETTE flashed the best speed, was leading leaving the half mile pole but jumped a shadow caused by a light standard near the seven sixteenths, recovered but was overtaken by RUNFASTERELSE, battled that one to mid stretch but weakened to the line. RUNFASTERELSE prompted the leader to the turn, inched to the front while two wide, could not shake loose in upper stretch and also weakened. FRANNIE FLYER was outrun to the turn, came two wide to the stretch but lacked the needed closing response.
