SABE broke alertly to set all of the pace from just off the rail, met a bid from MY ROYAL KNIGHT near the quarter pole, appeared to be headed by that rival a furlong out but fought back gamely inside and was up late. MY ROYAL KNIGHT stalked the winner from the outset, challenged two wide on the turn, seemed to gain a short lead at the furlong pole but could not quite match strides late. DEVIL'S ISSUE stalked the pace from off the rail into the stretch then lacked the needed response. CAPTAIN MAGIC was slow in the early stages, advanced four wide to the stretch but flattened out in the lane. SMOKIN PADRE broke slow and lacked good early speed, raced just off the rail to the turn and came on late. PRIMITIVO lagged early, raced in the three path on the turn and finished willingly. WOODEN HOOQ flashed speed to the turn, drifted wide to fall back but closed a minor gap in the stretch. QUICK N READY stalked the pace early, raced three wide on the turn and came up empty.
