SIX PACK ABS raced up inside to gain a short early lead without need of urging, edged clear on the turn and maintained the advantage to mid stretch but was fully extended to last. WEEKEND ESCAPE (IRE) broke a step slow but was quickly stalking the pace from the inside, remained inside on the turn, shifted out once in the stretch and was slowly gaining on the winner to just miss. TAXI FLEET was never far back from between horses, got shuffled back a bit on the turn but kept to his task in the lane and was closing the gap. FULL POWER AHEAD settled early, was caught in tight quarters leaving the half mile pole and slipped back, then tried to rally three wide into the stretch but lacked the needed response. SECOND HAND LION pressed the pace from the outside to the stretch and weakened. FORT FUNSTON stalked the pace but had no rally while four wide into the lane. FLAMING BULLET raced unhurried early, was fanned five wide while trying to rally on the turn and came up empty in the lane.
