Footnotes

WILLIE THE FOX raced up from the rail after the initial furlong and engaged EDIT THIS for the lead, battled that rival into the stretch then met a bold bid from BAMAHA BREEZE at the furlong pole, dug in and held gamely. BAMAHA BREEZE broke alertly but took back just off the dueling leaders under a snug hold, was permitted to advanced three wide into the stretch, got to terms with the winner a furlong out but could not get by. CASTLE DERMOT was permitted to settle early but was always within striking distance, advanced from the rail into the stretch, angled to the outside leaving the furlong pole and finished steadily to just miss. EDIT THIS dueled outside the winner to the furlong pole and slackened. FLASHY GREEN settled early, raced in the three path on the turn and went evenly through the stretch. SKIPPY DUE bobbed slightly at the start and was off a couple lengths slow, moved up outside into the turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch and did not rally.
