LOW GEAR POWER had no speed and was content to track the leaders from the rear, offered a bid to the second turn but was forced to rally five wide to the stretch, lugged inward in upper stretch, causing LUCKY BET to steady then straightened and dug in late to get the decision. WINNINGMOTION never far back to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch, drifted inward slightly in upper stretch then battled but was outfinished. SOVEREIGN ROAD alternated on the front end to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch, pushed clear to mid stretch then could not stall the top two. LUCKY BET lugged out five wide at the seven eighths then was straightened in the four path, stalked the leaders to the second turn, made his best bid four wide to the stretch, was weakening then was cut off by the winner, steadied nearing the three sixteenths and went evenly late. EL TEJON attended the pace nearest the rail to the half, was in the two path to the stretch and weakened through the drive. CAPITAL CAT broke in a tangle and was rank and hard to place on the first turn, tracked the leaders from the rail for six furlongs then gave out. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run involving the winner and LUCKY BET but in a majority decision allowed the original order of finish to stand, stating that although LUCKY BET was bothered, the incident did not cost him a better placing.
