RULE HE MUST chased the leaders to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch, responded to steady urging and closed steadily late to be along in time. GIANT STEPS contested the pace to the turn, was off the rail to the stretch, responded to mid stretch, led in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. GOLD COAST EXPRESS was on the pace outside of the runnerup, responded three wide to mid stretch but tired through the final furlong. ROCKIN HARBOR also chased the pace inside of the winner to the stretch but lacked a closing response. WARREN'S CONCEPT was outside rivals to the turn, came three wide to the stretch but failed to rally in the drive. PRINCE NOVETTI broke slow and was outrun out of the chute, raced two then three wide to the stretch but failed to threaten. SKATTLE SEATTLE leaned inward as the latch was sprung then straightened and broke in the air, losing about eight lengths and trailed throughout.
