Footnotes

MISS OOPS stalked the dueling leaders from the outside, advanced three wide into the stretch, rallied steadily to gain command in the final seventy yards and edged clear driving. GREAT NEWS dueled from the rail, edged clear on the turn then was caught in the late stages. CASHMERE MIST broke a step slow start but was quickly in contention from the rail but lacked a solid closing response. STROPPIY was permitted to settle early, was two wide on the turn and finished in a mild rally. FLYING HOME lacked good early speed, was four wide on the turn and failed to rally. DREAM SPOTTER prompted GREAT NEWS for a half mile and came up empty.
