Footnotes

CRAZY THINKING raced up outside to gain command in the opening furlong and set all of the pace from off the rail, responded leaving the furlong pole and held driving. FANCY SUMMER prompted CRAZY THINKING from the outset, checked back from that rival leaving the three eighths pole and shifted to the outside then rallied steadily through the lane. PRINCESS SUSAN M lacked good early speed, came three wide to the stretch and finished willingly. PEEK A BOOP stalked the pace from the outset, raced three wide on the turn and lacked a closing response. CORNELIA MARIE lacked good early speed, raced two wide and between horses on the turn and closed a minor gap in the lane. STATELY APPEAL saved ground to no avail. MUSIC TEACHER was well placed early, saved ground to the stretch and slackened. A LITTLE POLISH showed little.
