Footnotes

LOGICIAN tracked the pace in hand from the outside to the second turn, advanced two wide to be challenging for command at the three eighths pole, forged to the front near the furlong pole then drew clear driving. ROYAL CLASSIC was forwardly placed from the rail throughout then finished steadily for the place without being a serious threat to the winner. SLEW A SOLDIER settled well off the pace early, advanced three wide on the second turn but flattened out in the drive. ROY'S LAST ROAR set all of the pace from the rail to the stretch then slackened. SHARPSTER hopped at the start and settled early, became a bit rank nearing the finish line the first time and steadied sharply off heels, settled again and stalked the pace to the second turn but had no response when called upon. STEPPIN CHARLIE was void of any early speed to lag far back to the second turn then closed a gap but never reached contention. NUMEROUS XS was an early factor then bore out badly on the second turn and fell back.
