Footnotes

BATON ROO settled early in mid pack and was three wide to the backstre3tch, moved up three wide behind the bunched leaders into the stretch, found between horses in mid stretch, responded willingly and was up late to win driving. DYNAMIC HOST raced unhurried early from the rail, swung three wide on the second turn and closed willingly from the extreme outside. MARINE FOG was always within striking distance from off the rail, advanced three wide into the stretch to loom a bold factor at the furlong pole but flattened out. PREMIUM QUALITY lagged early, was two wide to the stretch, eased out for room in the stretch but lost his punch late. FUNI ACT stalked the pace four wide from the outset, rallied to the lead in the stretch but slackened in the final furlong. SENATOR BOB checked early inside RED COATS R COMIN then settled to stalk the pace in hand, moved up from the rail to challenge for the lead into the stretch then gave way late. BERT' N THE GROUP raced unhurried early, was fanned five wide into the stretch while trying to rally then went evenly through the lane. UNVARNISHED saved ground to no avail. DEACON SPEAKIN' dueled three wide to the stretch, checked while tiring at the furlong pole and fell back. RED COATS R COMIN dueled from off the rail for six furlongs and came up empty in the stretch.
