Footnotes

BIG TIME SUNSHINE never far back to the second turn, bid inside to the stretch, shifted out to get around SATIN BOUQUET, cut off EXCESSIVE FASHION causing that one to clip heels, then responded to urging and raced clear driving. SATIN BOUQUET set all the pace for six furlongs, responded to mid stretch, could not stall the winner leaving mid stretch but had enough left to save the place. SINGLE N LOVIN IT trailed to the second turn, got fanned four wide while rallying to the stretch then was making up ground belatedly. ASTUZIA tracked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then was outfinished in the late stages. EXCESSIVE FASHION prompted the leader for six furlongs, was two wide into the stretch, got cut off by the winner just past the three sixteenths, clipped heels and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run and disqualified BIG TIME SUNSHINE for interfering with EXCESSIVE FASHION and placed her last.
