**Footnotes**

D'HONORABLE ONE broke on top then fell back, raced just off the rail on the turn, eased out for drive, responded to collar BLACKY THE BULL at the sixteenth pole and drew clear driving. BLACKY THE BULL raced up after the break to duel outside RECONSTRUCTION, gained a slim lead at the furlong pole but could not hold the winner in the final sixteenth. RECONSTRUCTION broke in stride and dueled for the lead from the rail to the upper stretch and slackened. SUCCESSFUL BLUFF was not asked for speed early, raced just outside the winner on the turn to rally into the stretch but lost his punch, stopped short of returning to the unsaddling area but did walk off. LA CAPITANA raced up inside in the opening quarter, steadied back while trying to get inside RECONSTRUCTION in tight quarters on the rail, fell back and lost contact with the field on the turn and was eased through the stretch but walked off.
