Footnotes

MONICA C C was unhurried for a half mile, bid two wide into the second turn, shifted out three deep into the stretch, rallied once straightened and closed steadily to be along in time. BIMBO MAGIC tracked the pace to the second turn, bid three wide on the second turn to engage for the lead to mid stretch, battled to deep stretch then was outkicked by the winner. JULES J set all the pace for six furlongs, responded to pressure to mid stretch but was tiring in the late stages. CASH QUEEN ANNA (IRE) never far back while saving ground to the second turn, remained inside to the stretch then came up empty when more was needed. TWO THIRDS VICTORY was four wide to the backstretch, trailed to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch but failed to offer the needed late response. LIVING OUR DREAM was rank and fighting the rider into the first turn, settled and pressed the pace to the second turn then gave way in the drive.
