SPOT ON BABE had good speed, dueled between rivals to mid turn, responded two wide to the stretch then edged away to mid stretch and held driving. WILD NICOLE had no speed, was roused into the turn but forced to circle rivals six wide to the stretch, responded in the drive and was game to the line. SO SO FAST had no speed, raced four then five wide while rallying to the stretch, loomed a threat to mid stretch then lost some punch. TO B A NOITTED broke a bit slow then was hustled up to chase the leaders, got pushed four wide while rallying to the stretch but came up empty in the final furlong. ROUST 'EM BERTIE contested the pace widest to the turn, was three deep to the stretch then tired in the drive. OH MY GODDESS broke alertly and was a pace factor to the turn, got outrun while saving ground to the stretch and also was tiring through the final furlong.
