CHOCOLATE CANDY broke alertly but was permitted to slip back into the first turn and raced four wide to the backstretch, began to advance leaving the five eighths pole and challenged for command outside a three horse spread at the half mile pole, dueled into the stretch, turned back RENDEZVOUS nearing the furlong pole to briefly draw clear then dug in late to hold MASSONE in the final strides. MASSONE raced under patient handling to the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, shifted inside CHOCOLATE CANDY leaving the furlong pole, got to that rival late but could not get by. RENDEZVOUS raced unhurried and outside MASSONE for five eighths, rallied four wide on the second turn to loom a bold factor into the stretch then flattened out. AXEL FOLEY settled early and raced just inside CHOCOLATE CANDY, appeared to gain a short lead from between the leaders at the half mile pole, dueled to the head of the lane then slackened. AQUICKSTING was bumped at the start but quickly recovered and sprinted to a clear lead, gave up much of the advantage into the second turn but remained a factor from the rail to the stretch then had little left. RAISING MEMO broke in and bumped with AQUICKSTING at the start then settled off that rival but was through after a half mile and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
