Footnotes

ELECTROLYTE was outsprinted to the turn, bid between rivals to the stretch then eased out for room, rallied when set down and collared GO MOJAVE GO in the late stages. GO MOJAVE GO The latter pressed the pace two wide to the stretch, moved up to engage for the lead in mid stretch, took a short lead in deep stretch but could not stall the winner. EL TIO FERNANDO had no speed, trailed to the turn, was forced to circle five wide to the stretch but closed determinedly in the final furlong. CAMMAZES set the pace from the rail to the stretch, resisted to mid stretch then weakened. JOHNSKI stalked the leader to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch but had little to offer in the final furlong. PREACHER'S BLUFF was chasing to the turn, got fanned to the four path to the stretch and lacked a closing response. LEO THE COP was outsprinted early, chased from the rail to the stretch and also did not rally. CAREER STUDENT broke a bit slow, had no speed and was not a factor.
