STAR FIELD stalked the leaders to the turn, was two wide to the stretch, shifted inside of the runnerup in upper stretch, was rallying on the fence while in tight quarters but gamely prevailed. ADRIATIC SKYE was on the pace to the turn, edged away while in hand and off the rail to the stretch, responded when set down but could not stall the winner. KISSY KITTY was also a pace factor to the turn, got outkicked by ADRIATIC SKYE while three wide to the stretch but kept to task and was closing ground late. DEFENDEROFFREEDOM tracked the pace to the turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch then finished willingly in the final sixteenth. WILD RULER got outsprinted in the early stages, chased the leaders four wide to the stretch but could not muster the needed late response. JUST ADD PEARLS was also outsprinted to the turn, tracked from the rail to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. I'M SO PUZZLED had no speed, was outrun while saving ground to the stretch then closed a minor gap late.
